

Keep the TSI Congress safe!

Please help us out:



- Have the required information (vaccination, recovery or test result) ready at registration without being asked.



- Wear a surgical mask in the entire event area. You may remove it only when you are seated or standing at a table.



- No handshaking or hugging - please use greeting methods without direct contact.



- Please sanitise your hands each time you enter the Radisson Blu Hotel and regularly during the Congress. Use the sanitiser dispensers provided outside all rooms for this purpose.



- Avoid touching your face, and please cough and sneeze into your elbow.
- Please keep a distance of 1.5 m. Please pay particular attention to this in the networking area

Please stay at home ...



- if you do not meet the entry and quarantine requirements of the Federal Foreign Office and the Federal Ministry of Health for your stay here in Germany. You will then have access to the live stream and the entire congress platform as a virtual participant,



- if you have been ordered to quarantine at home,



- if you have the slightest suspicion of infection within the last 14 days,
- if you feel ill (fever, dry cough, loss of taste or smell),
- if you have had contact with a (potentially) infected person.

Our setup of the TSI Congress 2021 in Berlin taking into account the current regulations of the Governing Mayor of Berlin:

- Admission only for vaccinated, recovered or tested persons
- Masks must be worn in all rooms and spaces of the event premises
- Minimum social distancing requirements apply in all areas
- Presentation areas are designed with generous social distancing arrangements (chairs, tables)
- Sanitiser dispensers in front of every room and at every buffet
- Additionally: hand washing and sanitising facilities in the toilets in the conference area on the ground floor and in the DomLounge.
- Regular cleaning and disinfection of contact surfaces ensured by the hotel
- Continuous ventilation of the entire hotel with comfort air conditioning (complete air exchange, no air circulation!)
- Measures to maintain distance between staff and attendees (e.g. partitions) and avoidance of queues
- No access for persons with symptoms of illness
